Long Lasting Insecticide Nets (LLIN's) will be provided to villagers where malaria outbreaks are uncontrolled. LLIN's are scientifically proven to sharply reduce the incidence of malaria when used nightly. Surveys will be conducted where LLIN's have already been distributed, to determine the impact of the nets and their acceptance by tribal leaders and heads of households.
